Massage Therapist owned and operated for over 40 years, the Idaho School of Massage Therapy (ISMT) offers a non-accredited entry-level Massage program registered with the State Board of Education. We recognize a need and growing market for knowledgeable, skillful, intentional massage therapists who also possess the “trifecta” of attributes for success in massage therapy: professionalism, a business plan and communication skills. ISMT is a small school offering day and evening classes for a Massage Therapy Program that exceeds Idaho’s Massage Therapist License education requirements and features modalities from both western and eastern disciplines. Located at the heart of Treasure Valley, in Meridian, ISMT’s comprehensive curriculum continues to strike an ideal balance of clinical and wellness applications from relaxation to rehabilitation. Our in-person classes are taught by experienced, qualified faculty who focus on the skills and competencies necessary for the safe and effective delivery of therapeutic massage and bodywork. The Western coursework of Trimester A & B, builds upon the fundamental “Swedish 7”, adding Connective Tissue /Deep-Tissue and Sports massage with a solid base of human body sciences, while the Eastern coursework of Trimester C switches viewpoints with our Asian Bodywork and Reflexology to provide an holistic, energetic aspect. The allied modalities of Craniosacral, Lymphatic facilitation, Visceral and Geriatric massage are gentle, complementary medical massage therapies anywhere on the wellness to treatment spectrum. **Fulfill the program in this order to minimize completion time:**

2026-27 Tuition, Cancellation and Attendance Policy

Tuition Payments and Refunds:

ISMT does not accept any Federal student aid monies. We structure the tuition payments on a pay-as-you-go basis with no prepaid tuition. Classes are paid at the ½ point and end for each Trimester. State funds may be available through Job Service, Launch or Vocational Rehabilitation. Military personnel or their spouses may qualify for funding through the Veteran's Administration, GI benefits; check your eligibility and availability.

Tuition fees are not paid up front or in advance of classes therefore refunds do not apply. Students purchase their own books separately at additional cost (see Book List.)

Class tuition payments on a “pay as you go” or class-by class basis, as follows:

- **½ and 1½:** 50% of *tuition is due at the ½ and end* point of each Trimester or class.
- See Day or Evening Class Schedule, “Class Payments” for details and due dates.

A student that follows the schedule of classes and payments will complete the program with no outstanding debt to the school in approximately 10 months, with Trimester A start point.

Cancellation, Withdrawal, or Dropped classes:

A student may “drop” or “withdraw” from a class in writing *before* the ½ point of class transpires; voiding the class, *and incurring no tuition*. Withdrawal from a class beyond this point (50% or greater) will incur tuition fees though zero credit hours accrue and is **effective on the date and time of receipt** of written or emailed official notification, not the date of last class attendance.

- Withdrawals/drops at 0% - 49% of a class: No tuition is owed.
- Withdrawals/drops at 50% - 59% of a class: ½ Tuition is owed at minimum, for class transpiring up to receipt of written drop notice, calculated at \$18.00/class-hour.
- Withdrawals/drops at 60% - 89% of a class: Tuition is owed, at \$20/class-hour.

Consider this official notice that certifications and transcripts can and will be held back if tuition and/or fees are owed the school.

TOTAL Tuition for classes comprising the 650-hr. Massage Program Certification:

\$ 100 Application Fee, \$50 Hydrotherapy Fee, \$120 Student Insurance; all non-refundable fees.

Each student shall obtain their own books, supplies and provide proof of Student insurance (through massage trade associations: AMTA, AMBP, or equivalent at their own expense.) See Admission Requirements. Books and supply costs are not included in the tuition (See Book and Supply List.)

Attendance: Students must have a minimum 90%; makeup classes available at additional cost to student. 1 hour of Makeup = 3 hours of classroom time at a cost of \$30/hr. 70% or higher minimum competency for class credit. Some restrictions apply. See Student Handbook for detail.

“Work-off” a portion of your tuition doing supervised Student Clinic massages on campus beyond the 110-hour requirement. Some restrictions apply, see Student Handbook for detail.

Transfer Credit may be available for classes “substantially equivalent.” Course transcripts and syllabus required. Business I/Ethics and Student Clinic hours are non-transferrable. We cannot guarantee transfer of credit to/from other schools. Inquire about course “Challenge”: a fee of \$30/course applies. Courses may be taken individually with **completion of the admission process** in its entirety. See Admission Requirements.

Trimester A is the recommended starting point for the massage program. Trimester A classes are only offered September to December each year. Trimester A is the first half of the Western Massage Section and Trimester B is the second half. These foundational classes emphasize *medical terminology and body sciences; massage theory, effects, benefits, cautions, contraindications, ethics of touch, general guidelines and the basis of most massage: Swedish massage. ISMT strongly encourages applicants to start here.*

Trimester B is the 2nd half of the Western Massage Section and is not recommended as a starting point for the massage program. Bodywork 102 builds on Swedish and Bodywork 101. Pathology and Kinesiology build on Anatomy and Physiology. Trimester B classes are only offered January through April each year. The emphasis for this trimester is on *clinical pain management, injury recovery, and intermediate body sciences: pathology and kinesiology, keeping of professional records/ Business and Movement classes are Trimester B & C classes only. Business 1 is required for the Ethics hours and like the Movement classes are not eligible for Challenge.*

Though Trimester B start is avoided 90% of the time, it can be beneficial to take Business 1 and Movement at this time, as Business II is offered in Trimester C. For individuals who have a preexisting education in Business, inquire about a Test-out or Challenge of the Business II class by scheduling the Exam and getting a Satisfactory score of 70% or better.

Trimester C is the beginning of the Eastern Massage Section and is the 2nd best place to enter the Massage Program. Students who choose to begin classes in Trimester C (April) must take Trimester A & B classes the following September and January to complete the massage program. This increases program completion from 10 months to 12.

Trimester C is an acceptable starting point for students who are willing to complete some outside study and practice to get familiar with basic guidelines covered in Trimester A. Trimester C classes emphasize several modalities aligned with eastern holistic philosophies and are only offered April through June each year. *Students take meditation class in this trimester to promote mental focus, and Business II to finalize the Business Plan started in Trimester B.*

Class sizes are typically small: 4-8 students, except Saturday classes which combine Day and Evening students. For more information, an Open House is held before each Trimester start. All Admission Requirements are to be submitted prior to Enrollment/Registration and Student Orientation. Class details for each trimester and course syllabus’ available at Trimester Student Orientation; attendance is required.

Completion of all three trimesters, payment of all fees, return of all books loaned, passing grades of at least 70% in all classes and Student Clinic and a Final Demonstration of Skill comprehensive Practical Exam qualifies the student to receive an official transcript and a Massage Program certificate of completion. State Licensing requirements include completion of approved education program and receiving a passing grade on a State approved Massage Licensing Examination given by an independent entity.
